Paul will talk about the stock assessments and eel research Rangitāne have done over the last 5-10 years

Rangitāne are an eel people practicing aquaculture and fisheries management on a grand scale. The once vast wetland of te Tapere Nui o Whatonga sustain the uri o Rangitāne for almost 800 years.

Modern impacts have decimated eel stocks to a point that the iwi no longer provide it to their manuhiri. TE Ao Turoa Enviro-Centre have been researching the state of current stocks and looking at ways that we can regenerate the bounty of old
