Speaker: Ken New, Places for Penguins project

Ken will talk about the little Penguins or little blue penguins (kororā) and the work 'Places for Penguins Project' is doing around the Wellington area. The Project aims are to provide safe nesting sites for little blue penguins to protect them from car strike and predators. 'Places for Penguins' currently builds and places nest boxes on the seaward side of the road, monitors nests and monitors traps and bait stations. 'Places for Penguins Project' is a Wellington Forest & Bird project based on Wellingtons South Coast and was started in 2007
